STATE PARK ENTRANCE LICENSE POLICY BELLE FOURCHE PUBLIC LIBRARY

State Park Entrance Licenses will be loaned to patrons 18 years and older who are registered patrons of the Belle Fourche Public Library. Patrons may be asked to show their driver's license to prove age.

Borrowers may not have outstanding fines or fees or have any materials that are overdue.

Only the patron whose name is on the library card being used may check out the entrance license and must have the card with them or be prepared to purchase a replacement library card.

Entrance licenses will be checked out to patrons free of charge.

Only one entrance license may be borrowed at a time.

Patrons may check out the entrance license for up to three days.

A patron may check out an entrance license once per month.

There are no renewals or consecutive check outs for entrance licenses.

There will be no reserves put on entrance licenses.

Entrance licenses must be returned to the front desk or in the DVD return basket if the library is not open.

Entrance licenses not returned on time will be charged \$5.00 per day.

Patrons who return entrance licenses late more than twice will lose privileges for 6 months.

Patrons will be responsible for lost or damaged entrance licenses. The fee for these licenses is \$80.00.

We ask that patrons complete the survey when the entry license is returned. The survey is a QR code linked to a Google form. There is also a PDF of the survey that can be used instead. Continuation of this program will be determined by responses from this survey. The program is made possible through a partnership between South Dakota Game, Fish and Parks (GFP) and the South Dakota State Library and with Library Services and Technology Act (LSTA) American Rescue Plan (ARP) funding available to the State Library through the Institute of Museum and Library Services (IMLS).
